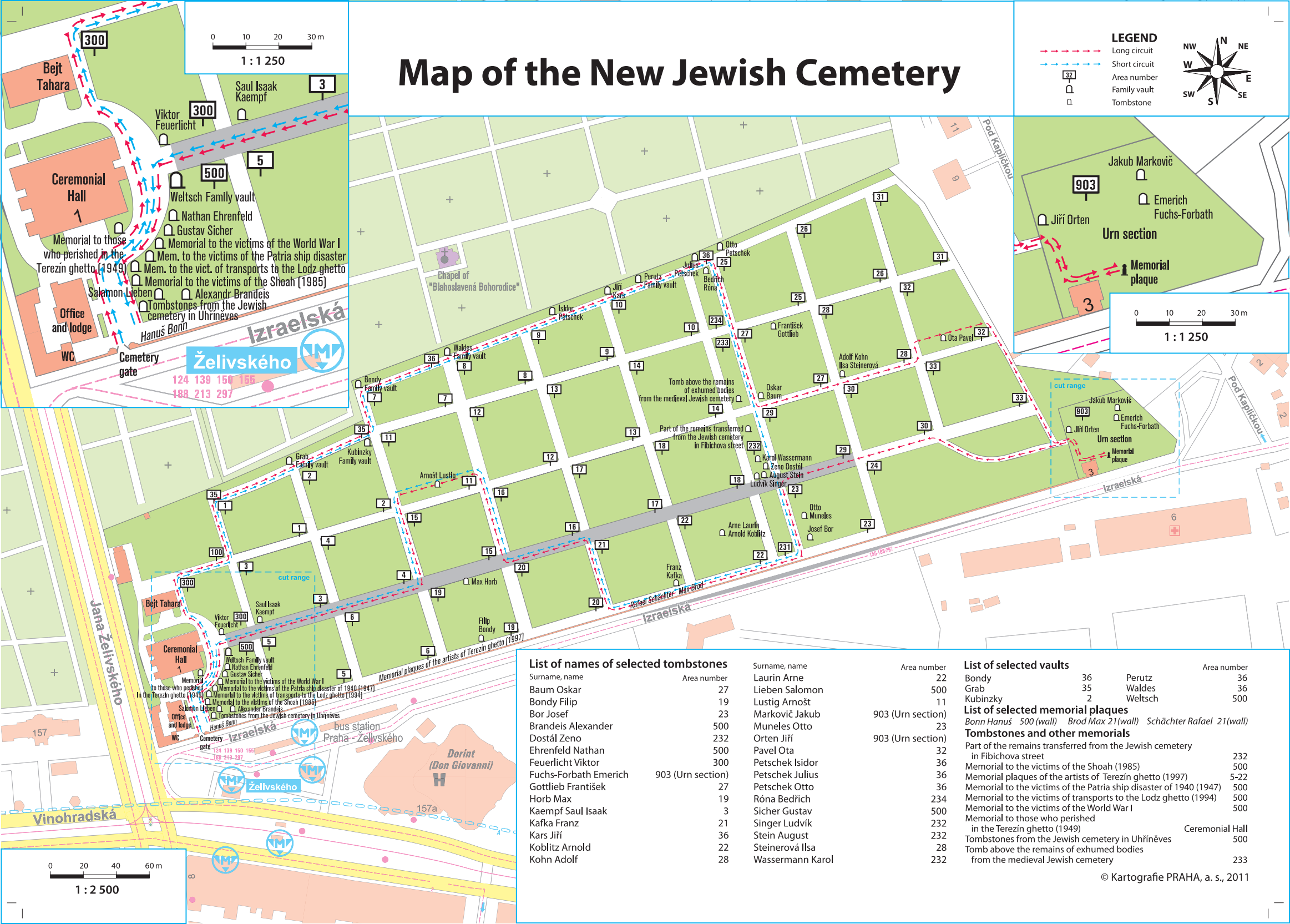
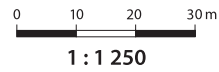


# Map of the New Jewish Cemetery
